#### Astro turf - Ongoing.

• Looking for a new supplier.

#### <u>Lower Car Park -Safe permanent wheelchair access to crawler hill and fast buggy track.</u>

- Ken screenshared arial pictures of the before, during and after the work on the car park.
- Wheel spinning of models is not allowed on the car parks.
- Electrical ducting has been installed from the container to the railway if it's decided in the future to run electric to the track.
